Points:

Maintainability of Writ-Whether writ court can direct the B.L.& L.R.O. to supply copy of record of right- Constitution of India Art. 226

Facts:

The petitioner is alleging inaction on the part of the Block Land and Land Reforms Officer in that the Officer has not supplied copies of the record of rights.

Held:

In view of the provisions of the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal Act, 1997, the petitioner's remedy, if any, was before the Tribunal established under the Act. This Court has no jurisdiction to entertain the matter. Para 2

In view of the provisions of the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal Act, 1997, the petitioner's remedy, if any, was before the Tribunal established under the Act. This Court has no jurisdiction to entertain the matter.
